



## LESSON NOTES FOR “BLUEGRASS STOMP”

Here’s some information that you might find helpful before you start work on the lesson.

Bluegrass Stomp is in the key of D major.

Banjo, Dobro and Guitar do not use a capo.

There are two different tempos for Bluegrass Stomp – Learning and Performance. There is no Slow Jam Tempo as it is a medium tempo tune. The tempos for the different versions are:

Learning Tempo: 50bpm

Performance Tempo: 84bpm

The Learning Tempo has three mp3s (except for bass, which has two). The easier and advanced breaks come back to back, with the band, solo with a metronome click, and a version without your instrument so that you can practice playing along.

The Performance Tempo has three mp3s – with and without your instrument and an excerpt showing different styles of backup; the bass has a rhythm track only version.
